

WRAPAROUND COACHING COHORT

Purpose: The Wraparound Coaching cohort provides a group coaching experience for Wraparound leaders and supervisors to become certified Wraparound Coaches. As trained experts, coaches will play an integral role in maintaining fidelity to the model and implementing the coaching process.

About: The coaching cohort is a successful evidence-supported model designed to provide a structured setting where potential coaches can learn from certified coaches as well as their peers.

- Cohort participation is a commitment by the trainee and organization.
- The coaching cohort meets weekly for four months.
- Participants can choose one of two sessions.
- Every session will be approximately 2 hours.
- The cohort will be virtual using Zoom (video required).
- Participants must have access to a case manager to coach towards certification. (If the potential coach is not already a certified Wraparound facilitator, they must also have access to an individual or family available to receive Wraparound.)
- All participants must have completed the Wraparound 101 training. Organizations should commit to identified infrastructure changes to accommodate the Wraparound process before signing coaches up for the cohort.
- This entails providing support so that participants will be available for the Friday afternoon cohort meetings and the weekly activities involved in the certification process.

What to expect: Activities will be taught, reviewed, and observed through video or role-play. Participants are required to submit their scoring along with the coaching forms and/or recordings for that section. Feedback will be provided in the following session. Make-up sessions are available on a limited basis as needed.
