

Peace, Love, Wraparound

A Social Capital Fund

How it works:

The Peace, Love, Wraparound- Social Capital Fund is designed to provide incidental funding to families experiencing mental health conditions. All eligible participants must be enrolled in Wraparound.

The Wraparound facilitator should have exhausted alternative resources prior to applying for the Peace, Love, Wraparound- Social Capital Fund. The fund is not intended to pay for treatment or services but rather to enhance access to social support or pay for incidentals that will assist the client in having access to family, faith and friends.

Examples of potential purchases include extracurricular activities, supplies for hobbies or classes, and one-time gas money to get to and from activities.

Criteria:

Family identifies a need that is not covered under insurance.

That need is identified on the written Wraparound Plan.

There should be evidence that other sources have been tried.

The Peace, Love, Wraparound- Social Capital Fund is not intended to pay for services or supports that can be funded through alternative methods.

The Wraparound facilitator completes the application.

Process:

The Wraparound facilitator will complete the application for funding and submit it online with a copy of the Wraparound plan. Please complete the application- it must be fully completed for submission.

Make sure you click the submit button and receive a confirmation on the webpage.

Within 48 hours each member of the Peace, Love, Wraparound Social Capital Fund Committee will review the application and approve or disapprove funding.

Notification will be provided to the Wraparound facilitator within 48 hours

If the request is approved the Wraparound Facilitator will provide Peace, Love, Wraparound with information for Venmo, Zelle, or where to receive a check (though this will delay the process).

Money will be sent to the Wraparound facilitator via Venmo or Zelle

After the purchase has been made the Wraparound facilitator will upload a receipt to the website (this is required should future funding be sought)
